Section 1: Introduction

- The Miss _____ Organization is a non-profit corporation organized under 1.1. the laws of the State of . The Miss Organization has operated a program offering scholarship assistance and career opportunities for the young women within the State of _____. In doing so, The Miss Organization has made substantial investments in, and has developed a valuable identity for, the unique symbols and elements of the Program that have achieved national and even international recognition and approval. These elements include but are not limited to (1) providing educational assistance in the form of scholarships to young adult women who have not yet begun to assume the responsibilities of family life and are interested in career and educational advancement; (2) recognizing and honoring the traits of honesty, good character, talent, poise, intellect, leadership and good judgment in the young women of America who enter the competition (the "Contestants"); and (3) enabling the Contestants to serve as role models for other young women with similar goals and personal characteristics.
- 1.2. The Miss ______ Organization intends to conduct a competition for the title "Miss ______ 200_," to be held in ______ on _____, 200_. The competition is a critically important, and the single most visible and widely recognized, element of the Program. The competition is conducted in a fashion that is designed to combine a respect for the traditional and historic foundations of the Program with recognition of the perceived modern tastes and values of the American people.

1.3. The winner of the competition shall be designated "Miss _______ 200____," and shall be entitled to that title until her successor is named at the competition in ______ 200___. During this period (the "Year of Service"), Miss ______ 200___ shall be required to engage in travel and participate in personal appearances throughout the State. These activities are designed, scheduled, arranged and supervised by The Miss ______ Organization in order to reflect the values and standards of the Program and to enhance its visibility and maintain its broad public acceptance. The Miss ______ Organization has also developed detailed procedures and requirements that govern the activities and conduct of Miss ______

during her Year of Service. All of these procedures, standards and requirements are intended to protect and enhance the substantial public acceptance of the Program among the American people, and to assure that the Program will continue to be able to operate for the benefit of the thousands of young women who will be seeking to participate in the Program in future years.

- 1.4. In seeking to participate in the competition, each Contestant must understand and accept the requirements of the Program, including the rules for the contestants and the guidelines and limitations that will be applicable to her activities during her Year of Service if she is selected as Miss _______. In addition, each Contestant must understand and accept that the Miss _______ Organization's approval of the Contestant's participation in the competition and, if selected, service as Miss _______ will be specifically based upon the representations and agreements in this Application and Contract and its attachments and the continued compliance with all of the regulations of the Program. In such regard, I acknowledge that my ability to compete in the pageant shall be subject to review at each level of competition shall not in and of itself be the basis of my eligibility to compete in the Local, State and/or National Finals.
- 1.5. Therefore, by signing this Application and Contract and submitting it to the Miss _______Organization for approval, the Contestant represents and agrees that (1) all facts and representations contained in this Application and Contract and its attachments are true and accurate; (2) the Contestant agrees to abide by all rules and regulations of the Miss ______ Organization described in this Application and Contract and its attachments, in the period before and during the Year of Service; and (3) the Contestant meets each requirement for eligibility set forth in Section 2 of this Contract; and (4) the Miss ______ Organization shall have the sole discretion to determine whether, in its judgment, the Contestant may continue to participate in the Miss ______ Program, in the event that the Miss ______ Organization determines that any statement or representation by the Contestant is not true and accurate or that any action by the contestant is inconsistent with the rules and regulations of the Program.

- 2.1. I have never before competed in any National Finals of the Miss America Organization.

- 4.2. Conduct of the Competition. I understand and agree that the Miss ______Organization shall determine the manner and method of conducting the competition in its sole discretion. I further understand and agree that the Miss ______Organization shall also determine the time, method and manner of judging the competition and the awarding and supervision of all scholarships in its sole discretion. The decision of the persons designated by the Miss ______Organization to judge the various events in any and all matters pertaining to the selection of the winners shall be final in all respects.
- 4.3. *Televising and Sponsorship of Competition*. I understand that the Miss Organization makes no representations to me that the competition will be televised or broadcast on either a live or tape-delay basis, or that the competition will be sponsored by one or more sponsors, or that I will be personally or individually involved in any specific appearance in any broadcast.
- 4.4. Permanent License of Publication Rights. - 5.2. Availability for Appearances and Events. I agree to make myself available for such personal appearances, interviews, testimonials, endorsements, filming, tapings, photographic and recording sessions and other and various commitments and events related to my Year of Service that the Miss Organization has made and will make for me in its sole discretion.
- 5.3. Independent Contractor Status. I understand and agree that I am and will remain an independent contractor with respect to the Miss _______Organization and that I am not and will not become an employee of the Miss _______Organization during my Year of Service. The authority granted by this Application and Contract to the Miss _______Organization to act on my behalf is intended for the mutual convenience of the Miss _______Organization and myself and in order to provide an effective means of organizing my activities during my Year of Service, and not for the purpose of directing my performances or controlling my activities as if I were an employee of the Miss _______Organization.
- 5.4. Development of Platform. I understand and agree that an important element of the Program is the development of a central theme with national impact and importance that can form the basis for my appearances and presentations (the "Platform"). I agree to work with the Miss ______ Organization to select and pursue an appropriate Platform that will enable me and the Miss ______ Organization to maximize the impact of my Year of Service and further the goals of the Program by creating goodwill and recognition for the Program throughout the United States.
- 5.5. Appointment of the Miss ______ Organization as Exclusive Agent and Representative. Commencing with my selection as Miss ______ and throughout my Year of Service and until my successor is selected or appointed, I irrevocably constitute and appoint the Miss

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Organization as my sole and exclusive agent, representative and attorney-in-fact with the authority to:

- 5.5.3. sign, make, execute and deliver all contracts in my name in connection with any appearances or other obligations which are related to my service as Miss ______ which are to be fulfilled after the completion of my Year of Service, provided that I have consented in writing to the terms of such contracts;
- 5.5.4. determine the appropriate compensation that I shall receive for appearances or other activities related to my Year of Service.
- 5.5.5. collect and receive for and on my behalf all proceeds, monies or other compensation that is due or to become due to me by reason of any performance, service, appearance, engagement or contract;
- 5.5.6. choose and designate my traveling companions; and
- 5.5.7. select the appropriate modes of public or private transportation for me and my traveling companions, including the determination of the appropriate levels of travel service and the designation of the means of travel, such as fixed-wing or helicopter aircraft, rail, boat, ship, automobile, bus or van.
- 5.6. Sponsorship Fees and Payments to the Miss ______ Organization. I understand and agree that, in addition to the payments that the Miss _______ Organization, as my exclusive agent and representative, negotiates and approves on my behalf for my compensation for my appearances and services, the Miss _______ Organization may also contract for and receive sponsorship fees and other payments related to my appearances that will be paid directly to the Miss _______ Organization. I understand and agree that I shall not be entitled to receive any portion of these fees or payments.
- 5.7. *Numbers of Appearances.* I understand and agree that the Miss Organization has made and makes no representations

to me as to the number or nature of the appearances that I may be asked to make or the amount of compensation that I will receive during my Year of Service.

- 5.8. *Prior Contracts.* I understand that, prior to the competition, the Miss ______Organization will be required to enter into contracts and commitments for the appearances and services of the Contestant who will be selected at the competition. I agree that such contracts will be binding on me to the same extent as if the Miss _____ Organization had entered into them on my behalf after the commencement of my Year of Service.
- 5.9. *Membership in Unions*. If and when requested by the Miss ______ Organization, I agree to become a member of such unions or guilds as may be necessary in order to appear as a variety artist or for fashion purposes in any film, taped or recorded radio or television products, commercials, motion pictures, photographic sessions or personal appearances.
- 5.10. Prohibition of Endorsement of Competing Products and Services. I acknowledge that the Miss ______ Organization has contracted in the past, and will contract in the future, for the financial support of commercial companies and organizations, whose advertising commitments and other sponsorships are an important element of the financial stability of the Program. I agree that I will not in any way endorse or permit my name or likeness to be used in connection with the endorsement or advertisement of any products or services competitive to the products or services of an advertiser, sponsor or licensee of the Miss ______ Organization, during my Year of Service unless the Miss ______ Organization approves such an endorsement or advertisement in writing. I understand that the Miss _______ Organization is under no obligation to approve or consent to any such endorsement or advertisement after the end of my Year of Service.
- 5.11. *Appearances after Year of Service*. After the conclusion of my Year of Service, I will not wear the crown of Miss ______, nor appear as Miss ______ for the purposes of advertising or endorsing any product, person, cause or service, unless I have received in advance the written approval of the Miss ______ Organization. I understand that the Miss ______ Organization shall not be obligated to approve any such appearance or use of the Miss ______ crown.
- 5.12. Use of the Miss ______ Titles, Words and Symbols after Year of Service. After the conclusion of my Year of Service, if I am advised by the Miss ______ Organization that, in its sole and exclusive judgment, my use of any of the titles, words or symbols associated with the Miss ______ Organization and the Program has caused or is reasonably likely to cause harm to the Miss ______ Organization, I agree to discontinue any such use immediately. I understand and agree that the judgment of the Miss _______ Organization on this question shall be final and binding.

- 5.13. *Permanence of Restrictions*. I understand and agree that the provisions of Sections 5.11 and 5.12 of this Application and Contract shall specifically survive the termination of this Application and Contract and shall be enforceable by the Miss ______ Organization and binding on me in perpetuity.
- 5.14. Change in Circumstances. I understand that if, at any time between the competition at which I am selected as Miss and the completion of my Year of Service, any facts concerning my eligibility to participate in the Program should change, including without limitation my citizenship, marital or parental status, good character and reputation, or if I should become, in the sole judgment of the Miss _____ Organization, physically unable to perform the duties and obligations relating to my Year of Service, the Miss Organization shall have the right, in its sole discretion, to determine that I am not eligible to continue to serve as that event. Miss In the Miss _ Organization may, at its option, forfeit my title and all prizes, awards and perquisites of the position of Miss or both or either, subject to the provisions of Section 6.4 of this Application and Contract.

Section 6: Legal Obligations and Agreements

- 6.1. Unauthorized Use of Titles. I acknowledge and agree that the title "Miss "that I presently hold; the title "Miss America;" and the name and designation "Miss America Pageant" and "Miss America Organization" are the property of the Miss America Organization. I agree never to use, or to authorize anyone else to use, the words "Miss ", "Miss America" or "Miss America Pageant" or "Miss America Organization," or any similar or related phrase, in association with me or my name or likeness in any way without prior written approval.
- 6.2. Authorization of Publication. I authorize the use of my name, likeness, photographs, pictures, physical depiction, endorsement rights, and my title(s) by Organization and by such persons, firms or the Miss corporations may be approved and selected by the Miss as Organization. The Rights may be used and re-used by the Miss Organization, or anyone designated and licensed by the Miss ____ Organization, for publicity, advertising or any other use in any medium, all as deemed appropriate by the Miss Organization in its sole discretion. I will ensure that all rights that any officially sanctioned photographer (s) may have in any official publicity photographs of me are released by that photographer (s) in favor and that any such photographer (s) shall provide a written release of such rights on a form acceptable to the Miss Organization. I understand and agree that the provisions of this section shall specifically survive the termination of this Application and Contract.

- 6.5. Scholarship Grants and Forfeitures. I understand and agree that the grant of scholarships by the Miss ______ Organization is subject to the terms and conditions of the Scholarship Rules and Regulations attached to this Application and Contract as Attachment "C". By signing this Application and Contract, I agree to be bound by those rules and regulations. I understand that all scholarships that I may be awarded will be non-forfeitable in the event that I breach this Contract or fail to perform any duties that I may have as a Contestant. I also understand and agree, however, that such scholarships may be forfeited if I have made any misrepresentations as to my eligibility to compete.
- 6.6. Documents and Information; Cooperation with Inquiries. I agree to provide the Miss ______ Organization, at its request, with any documents or information necessary to determine any question with regard to my initial or continuing eligibility to compete or to complete my Year of Service. I also agree to cooperate fully with any inquiry undertaken by the Miss ______ Organization in connection with my initial or continuing eligibility, and to provide sworn statements and any relevant documents if requested to do so by the Miss ______ Organization.
- 6.7. *Termination of Eligibility*. I understand and agree that if:
 - 6.7.1. any of the representations or statements made by me in this Application and Contract or any of its attachments is determined by the Miss ______Organization to be false;
 - 6.7.2. there is a change of circumstances that would affect my eligibility to participate in the competition or to complete my Year of Service, including without limitation changes in my citizenship, marital or parental status, good character and reputation or, if relevant to my eligibility to participate in the competition, my residence, employment or educational status;

- 6.7.3. I fail to conduct myself in a manner which, in the sole and exclusive judgment of the Miss ______ Organization, is consistent with the standards and dignity of the Program; or

- 6.9. Uniqueness of Contract and Services; Injunctions. I understand and agree that the services and obligations described in this Application and Contract are unique and extraordinary and that there is no adequate remedy at law for any breach of this Application and Contract by me. Therefore, in the event of any such breach, or in the event of such a breach that is attempted or threatened, I agree that the Miss Organization shall be entitled to equitable relief by way of injunction or otherwise to prevent or repair such breach or attempted or threatened breach.

In that event, the remainder of this Application and Contract shall remain in full force and effect.

6.12. Arbitration of Disputes. Any controversy or claim arising out of or relating to this Application and Contract or any breach thereof shall be submitted to arbitration in Atlantic City, New Jersey in accordance with the Rules of the American Arbitration Association. Judgment upon any award rendered by the arbitrator(s) may be entered in any court having jurisdiction thereof. This Section shall not in any way affect the rights of the Miss ______ Organization to (1) seek injunctive relief as provided in Section 6.9 of this Application and Contract, or (2) take any action permitted by this Application and Contract to enforce the eligibility standards of the Program in the event that time does not permit the completion of an arbitration process before action must be taken.

Attachment D 2008 Rules and Regulations

1. Scholarship Funds and Academic Expenses:

- a. The Miss Utah Scholarship Pageant Organization, ("MUSPO") will authorize distributions from the Miss Utah Scholarship Fund at the Bank of American Fork-Lehi Branch, under the following circumstances:
 - i. Tuition, Textbooks and Academic Fees

Scholarship funds shall be expended for tuition, textbooks and academic fees for any courses taken at the college level. Payment of such expenditures will be made directly to the college, university or other accredited institution. MUSPO will disperse scholarship funds for such expenses only upon written request by the contestant accompanied by invoices from an academic institution.

ii. All Other Academic-Related Expenses

The MUSPO Executive Board must approve all other academicrelated expenses. To seek approval, the contestant must submit a written request explaining the expense, along with supporting documentation from the academic institution, to the MUSPO Executive Board twenty-one (21) days prior the required payment date of the expense.

b. Priority of Scholarship Usage

Contestants must use the scholarships won at the local level prior to applying for their state scholarship. Contestants must submit a letter from the local pageant Executive Director which verifies that all local scholarships have been exhausted.

c. Taxability of Scholarship Income

It is possible that any money paid directly to the contestant may be taxable. Monies paid directly to the college or university are not taxable. Contestants are encouraged to consult a tax advisor regarding the taxability of the scholarship payments.

d. Time Frame for Scholarship Usage

All contestants other than Miss Utah must use their scholarship monies

within one (1) year from the date of the award unless a reasonable extension is requested and granted. Miss Utah must use her scholarship within two (2) years from the date of the award unless a reasonable extension is requested and granted. Extensions will only be granted for a total of (3) years. If a contestant has no activity in her scholarship account during this period, the funds in her account will be forfeited. Any forfeited or unused portions of the scholarship will revert to the Miss Utah Scholarship Pageant Fund and be held in trust for future awards.

2. Living Stipend

Miss Utah will be paid a stipend of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) per month and fifty percent (50%) of all appearance fees collected above that amount, up to one thousand dollars (\$1000.00) per month.

3. Appearances

a. Preparation for Appearances

Miss Utah shall perform the necessary preparation for each appearance including, but not limited to, writing her own speeches and specifically targeting them towards the audiences she will address, reviewing any material provided to her for preparation purposes and preparing a talent selection if necessary.

Miss Utah shall have a substantial and appropriate repertoire of talent performances for all her appearances.

b. Follow-Up for Appearances

Miss Utah shall follow-up each appearance, sponsorship, donation or gift received with written correspondence expressing appreciation for the client/sponsor's generosity.

c. Wardrobe for Appearances

Miss Utah shall dress appropriately for all appearances. The MUSPO Business Manager will provide Miss Utah with information on wardrobe requirements prior to all appearances.

Miss Utah may not make any appearances in a swimsuit or any other inappropriate attire at any time.

MUSPO and sponsors will supply some wardrobe items for Miss Utah's appearances and competition at Miss America. MUSPO retains ownership of all wardrobe items purchased by MUSPO or by sponsors. Such

wardrobe items must be returned to MUSPO at the end of Miss Utah's year of service.

Miss Utah will not lend or let anyone wear any item of her wardrobe unless such use is specifically approved by MUSPO.

4. Promotion of the Miss Utah and Miss America Organizations

During Miss Utah's Year of Service she shall be a spokesperson not only for her personal platform issue and the national platform issue, but also for the Miss Utah and Miss America Organizations. Miss Utah shall continuously educate herself about the Miss Utah activities, programs, sponsors, and specifically its scholarship program in order to provide accurate responses when asked. In no way shall Miss Utah participate in conversations that are harmful and derogatory to the Miss Utah Scholarship Pageant Organization or the Miss America Organization.

If your resume arrives on the day of the deadline, but does not meet the criteria, there will not be time to return it to you; therefore, it will not be given to the judges. The contestant may explain the lack of judging materials during her interview, if she so chooses.

- 1. Go to the word processing program of your computer.
- 2. Start a "new" document
- 3. Set margins for 1" on all four sides. The font style may not be any smaller than "10" and no larger than "12" point type, using the Times New Roman font style. Please refer to the attached sample to verify you are following the requested format.
- 4. With the justification set for left, type "**Name:**" in **bold.** Following the colon (:), hit the space bar twice. Then, type your name as you wish the judges to know it. (If your name is Linda Deborah Smith and you want to be known as "Deborah Smith", please type "Deborah Smith).
- 5. Then, move to the next line and type "**Title:**" in **bold**. Following the colon (:), hit the space bar twice. Then, type your state title.
- 6. Then, move to the next line and type "**Hometown:**" in **bold**. Following the colon (:), hit the space bar once. Then, type your hometown including the city and the state.
- Move to the next line. Now set your justification to the right. Type "Date of Birth:" in bold. Hit the space bar two (2) times, and type the month, day, and year of your birth. (Ex. October 10, 1979)
- 8. Move Justification to the left. Double space down and type "Education:" in bold. Hit the tab bar three times and then type your most recent school first. If it is grad school, indicate it as such. List degree seeking (all on the same line as the name of the school), move to the line underneath that to list your undergraduate school and degree sought/achieved, and below that list your high school.

- 19. Double Space down. Type "Why I should be Miss Utah this year:" in bold. Hit the space bar twice. Explain to the judging panel why you should be selected Miss Utah and, more importantly, why you should be selected Miss Utah this year. Why is it critical for you to be Miss Utah right now?

The entire form MUST FIT ON ONE PAGE using the Times New Roman font style. You must leave a 1" margin on all four sides of the page

Use your best judgment on what is most important for the judges to know about you. Use your space wisely. Attached you will see an example of what it should look like. The contestant may explain the lack of judging materials during her interview, if she so chooses.

- 1. Go to the word processing program of your computer.
- 2. Start a "new" document
- 3. Set margins for 1" on all four sides. The font style may not be any smaller than "10" and no larger than "12" point type using the Times New Roman font style.
- 4. With the justification set for left, type **"Name:" in bold**. Following the colon (:), hit the space bar twice. Then, type your name.
- 5. Then, move to the next line and type **"Title:" in bold**. Following the colon (:), hit the space bar twice. Then, type Your state title
- Double space down. Set your justification to "center". They type in <u>bold and underline</u> the title of your Platform.
- 7. Double space down. Write what you feel is critical for the judge's to know about your platform and why it is necessary for you to have the job of Miss America to promote this issue. What you write will be what the judges know about your platform, your role in successfully dealing with this issue, and the role the Miss America Organization may play in your plan.
- 8. This essay **may** include some of the following items (this is not to be meant as an exhaustive list):
 - ? A clear definition of the platform and the specific issues you wish to address
 - ? A plan on how you have or will create awareness of the platform
 - ? The way in which you have or will change attitudes regarding the issue
 - ? The way in which you have or will change behaviors related to this issue
 - ? The way in which your platform issue will move the Miss America Organization forward
 - ? Your media plans
 - ? Your marketing strategy
 - ? How you propose to fund your ideas/plans
 - ? Any significant accomplishments you have made in regard to your issue
- 9. At the bottom of the page, you **MUST** set the justification to the right. Type a line of 26 spaces. Below that line, you must type Signature/Date. Once you have printed the document, it is important that you SIGN and DATE the document as show in attached sample.

Registration Instructions for Local Pageant Contestants

Congratulations on becoming involved with world's largest provider of scholarship assistance for young women. Last year the Miss America Organization and its state and local organizations made available more than \$45 Million in scholarship assistance.

Beginning in 2007, Miss America developed a National Platform and has partnered with Children's Miracle Network – an alliance of children's hospitals. Children's Miracle Network is a non-profit organization dedicated to saving and improving the lives of children by raising funds for children's hospitals across North America. Each year the 170 Children's Miracle Network hospitals provide the finest medical care, life-saving research and preventative education to help over 17 million kids each year to overcome diseases and injuries of every kind.

This National Platform starts at the Local Pageants with the 2008 pageant year (these locals may take place in calendar year 2007 or 2008 with the winners going to the State 2008 Pageant).

How to register as a contestant of a local pageant

Each contestant is asked to register on-line at www.MissAmerica4Kids.org. At the bottom of the first screen is a button labeled "New Contestants - click here". Press that button and you are on your way. It will take you 5 minutes or less to register. After you click the New Contestants button you will get a screen like this:

Steps to registering for the National Platform:

1. Fill in all the data lines that have an asterisk at the beginning of them. All the data.

2. You have choices as shown in the dropdown boxes where it asks you to "Select..".

3. The Pageant State is where you are competing in a pageant.

4. The Pageant year currently is 2008. (These pageants have winners that will go to the State 2008 pageant and the pageants may be in calendar year 2007 or 2008.)

5. Title Competing For: is the title of the pageant you are currently, for this specific pageant, competing for. You are asked to return to this when you enter the next pageant and change this name to the pageant that you are then competing for. You may have multiple pageants that you enter.

6. Your expected minimum goal is \$100 for each local pageant level but you may select a higher goal. This minimum local pageant goal of \$100 is for the National Platform which is very similar to the personal platform that you may have.

7. Fill in everything with an * in front of the line.

8. Upload a picture (if you want to, this is optional) and less than 325KB & JPEG format.

9. Then click on Save to save the data.

10. You will get to a page that tells you that you have saved the data.

11. Next, click on "Send emails" on the left hand side and enter email addresses to send to your friends and family. (Fund raising tip: send one email to yourself to your own email address, then when you get

that email from the system, add a personal note to that email and forward that email to as many as you like within your own email system. You could ask for \$5, \$10, \$20 or whatever they can give to both great causes.)

12. Print out the Qualification Report from your website and provide that printout to your ED to show you have obtained at least the \$100 for a local pageant (or more).

The funds raised are under your name and roll-over to qualify you for future pageants within a Pageant Cycle. For example, if you raise \$300 then you are pre-qualified for 3 local pageants. But, for each pageant you compete in you must update your profile on MissAmerica4Kids.org to reflect that newly entered pageant name. If you win local pageant #2, then the \$100 excess (\$100 was used for each of the 2 local pageants leaving \$100 left over) is applied to the State Pageant minimum goal of \$250. When you raise \$400 during local pageant competition then you are qualified for all future local pageants within that local pageant cycle.

It is as simple as that. You may track your progress and see how you are doing. The more emails you send, the more funds you raise for both of these great organizations. Yes, these funds are for both entities – the donations help increase the future scholarship fund at the Local, State and National Levels, as well as go to supporting the children's hospitals.

So, please take 5 minutes and go to MissAmerica4Kids.org and register for the pageant you will be competing in. If you elect to compete in additional local pageants simply return to MissAmerica4Kids.org and update your pageant you are competing in (select the next pageant you are entering).
