

Parks Part-time Summer Maintenance Worker

DISTINGUISHING FEATURE OF THE CLASS:

The fundamental reason this classification exists is to perform a variety of park maintenance work under the general guidance of the Public Works Director. The employee in this class is to perform a variety of duties under the direction of the Parks & Grounds Supervisor, including but not limited to maintaining and caring for the cemetery, parks and city owned property.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

Parks and Grounds

- Mows and trims lawns, shrubs, etc;
- Trims trees, removes branches and debris;
- Fertilizes lawns and flower beds;
- Sprays for proper weed and pest control;
- Waters lawns, flower, shrubs, etc at proper intervals;
- Cleans leaves, limbs and other debris from city grounds;
- · Cleans rest rooms;
- Plants flowers, shrubs, trees, etc;
- Repairs lawn mowers and other tools;
- Cleans and performs minor repairs on buildings, picnic tables, playground equipment, etc;
- •Adhering to safety protocol in operating equipment.

Cemetery and Sprinkler System

Assists in the following:

- In cemetery, according to established protocol, measures and digs grave, removing headstone is necessary, and prepares grave, installs vault in grave;
- Closes grave, replaces grass and cleans up and does necessary repairs which may include sprinkler line damage, tree damage, headstone damage, etc;
- In a timely manner, operates, maintains and fixes automatic and manual sprinkler systems;
- •Maintains time clocks and computers on a regular basis;
- Sets or repair clocks as needed;
- Maintains automatic valves check or repair on a regular basis;

- Checks sprinkler lines for leaks and repairs as needed;
- Checks, repairs, and adjusts sprinkler heads (pop-up, standards, manual) on a regular basis;
- Maintains effective working conditions of drinking fountains and rest rooms;
- Stocks PVC part in various sizes and sprinkler heads according to inventory protocol.

Winterization (if employed through the fall)

- Turns off all water lines as appropriate for winter;
- Each fall, drains sprinkler lines, valves, drinking fountains, bathroom plumbing;
- Turns off all time clocks;
- Deposits appropriate winterization fluid in all valves and bathrooms.

NON-ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

• Assist other departments as assigned.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES:

Knowledge of:

• Parks and grounds maintenance;

Skills of:

• Repairing lawn mowers and other machines.

Ability of:

· Ability to get along well with fellow workers and to work independently

Additional Requirements:

- Must be at least 17 years old at time of appointment. (If under 18 will be limited on equipment use)
- Must possess a valid Utah driver's license.

• High school diploma or equivalent.
