### **Winter Snow Softball Tournament**

What is your family doing New Years day? Form up a snow softball team and come play in the second annual Salem Snowman Softball Tournament. Yes, that is right, softball in the snow. Salem Parks and Rec. will sponsor the first tournament of the year. Cost is \$120 per team. Teams are guaranteed 3 game and plenty of warm hot chocolate. Teams may be made up of men, women or mixed. The event is about fun. Teams must be registered by Tuesday, December 28<sup>th</sup>. Wood bats are used. Salem City will supply 1 bat per field.

### **Youth indoor Soccer**

Salem Parks & Recreation will offer indoor soccer for boys and girls graders 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup>. Leagues will be divided by gender. Team will play 4 vs. 4 on hard floor surface with small pop up goals and no goalie. The focus of play is quick passes and ball movement. A 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> grade league 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> league will be organized in each gender. Games will be played on Saturdays. Games will not conflict with the same age group of basketball games. Register today. Each team will have two scheduled practices prior to games starting on January 15<sup>th</sup>. ### **T-Ball, Coach Pitch and Machine Pitch**

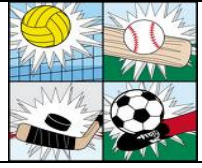

If we have enough girls sign up, we will do so. Coaches will pitch to players in both leagues. Coaches meetings will be held Wednesday, April 27<sup>th</sup>. League play will begin May 13<sup>th</sup>. 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### **Coaches Discount Policy - 10/15/08**

Salem Parks & Recreation offers various youth sports programs. Each program is organized and maintained by recreation staff. Coaching for all youth sports is done by volunteer coaches. Coaches are selected from a pool of volunteers, including solicitations of parents of participants.

Volunteer coaches will receive a \$20 or \$30 dollar voucher at the conclusion of the sport coached. These vouchers can be used for future registrations. The amount of the voucher is dictated by the sport each volunteer coaches in. \$20 voucher will be issued for all programs with an early fee of \$25 or less. The \$30 will be issued for all programs with an early fee cost of \$26 or more.

The voucher system is by no means an avenue for payment or compensation of the coach's time. It is a simple thanks you and acknowledgement of the coach's time and efforts. It is our belief that that majority of coaches, volunteer to spend time with their child as well as the youth of our community
